


INTESTACY FLOW CHART

If a person dies without a valid Will they are deemed to die "intestate". The effect of this is that the provisions of the *Queensland Succession Act* impose a statutory formula as to how that person's Estate is distributed. The formula is set out below:

The New Law (from 1 May 1998)



Notes

1. Those in the inner rings exclude those in the outer rings.
2. Issue take by representation
3. Nephews, nieces and cousins take between them only the share which their deceased parent would have taken had he or she survived.
